## IN THE EVENT OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY:

- REMAIN CALM AND DO NOT MOVE THE VICTIM UNLESS HIS/HER LOCATION POSES A POSSIBLE DANGER.
- IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY OR ASK SOMEONE IN THE VICINITY TO CALL 911
- LET EMERGENCY PERSONNEL KNOW IF THE VICTIM
- **O HAS TROUBLE BREATHING**
- **O IS UNCONSCIOUS**
- O HAS CHEST PAIN OR PRESSURE
- O IS BLEEDING SEVERELY
- O HAS PRESSURE OR PAIN IN THE ABDOMEN THAT DOES

  NOT GO AWAY
- O IS VOMITING OR PASSING BLOOD
- **O HAS A SEIZURE**
- O HAS A SEVERE HEADACHE OR SLURRED SPEECH
- APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN POISONED OR EXPOSED TO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS
- O HAS INJURIES TO THE HEAD, NECK, OR BACK
- **O HAS POSSIBLE BROKEN BONES**

CARE FOR LIFE-THREATENING CONDITIONS AND PROVIDE FIRST AID ONLY IF YOU HAVE THE PROPER TRAINING.
